INTRODUCTION

Soli deo Gloria: "GLORY to God ALONE."

GRAPHIC: God is Gracious: God gives undeserved kindness and favor

Question 1

WASHER: This is very, very important. God's motive for saving people is not found in that people.

To believe that God saw something inherently valuable in each of us is "Man-centered" instead of Godcentered.

That "All of a sudden the idea of grace is gone because [our salvation] is merited" (see Titus 3:5).

Question 2

Deuteronomy 7:7–8 (ESV) ⁷It was not because you were more in number than any other people that the Lord set his love on you and chose you, for you were the fewest of all peoples, ⁸but it is because the Lord loves you and is keeping the oath that he swore to your fathers, that the Lord has brought you out with a mighty hand and redeemed you from the house of slavery, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

GLORIFY means to magnify, praise, exalt.

Question 3

<u>James from Detroit</u> – the term glorify often means <u>to magnify in a positive way</u> – to zoom in with a magnifying glass on what that thing is and expose it for how beautiful it is

<u>**BEGG**</u>: When we come to the message of the Gospel, esp. in Ephesians, the motivation of God in redemption is that we might be to the praise of His glory.

Ephesians 1:5–6 (ESV) ⁵he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, ⁶to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved.

Question 4

Isaiah 48:9 (ESV) ⁹"For my name's sake I defer my anger; for the sake of my praise I restrain it for you, that I may not cut you off.

<u>Rosebrough</u> If God saved me because of my value then my focus is on myself and how amazing I am. In other words I'm worshipping myself. But if God saved me because of His love – Who He is, not who I am – then God's glory... His value... His worth is magnified.

James If God started pointing at us we'd be missing out on the greatest gift which is HIMSELF!

John 17:3–5 (ESV) ³And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. ⁴I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work that you gave me to do. ⁵And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed.

<u>James</u> So for God to glorify Himself and point the world to Himself He is actually doing the most loving thing possible because there is nothing more satisfying than God... there is nothing more lovely than God... there is nothing more lov-ING than God

God is <u>LOVE</u>: God eternally <u>GIVES</u> of Himself to others.

Question 7

The "Greatest gift which is Himself (God)." God, by pointing us to Himself, is "doing the most loving thing possible." God Himself is the most satisfying, lovely and most loving person in existence. The verse displayed is John 17:3-5.

Gospel Essentials: ORIGINALSin.
